

- 5. Examples of "Almighty" used in scriptures:
 - a. <u>Genesis 17:1</u> "When Abram was ninety-nine years old, the LORD appeared to him and said, "I am God Almighty; walk before me faithfully and be blameless."
 - b. Exodus 6:3 "I appeared to Abraham, to Isaac and to Jacob as God Almighty, but by my name the LORD I did not make myself fully known to them."
 - c. <u>Ruth 1:20</u> "Don't call me Naomi," she told them. "Call me Mara, because the Almighty has made my life very bitter."

- d. **<u>1 Samuel 15:2</u>** "This is what the LORD Almighty says: 'I will punish the Amalekites for what they did to Israel when they waylaid them as they came up from Egypt."
- e. <u>Romans 9:29</u> "It is just as Isaiah said previously: "Unless the Lord Almighty had left us descendants, we would have become like Sodom, we would have been like Gomorrah."
- *f.* <u>James 5:4</u> "Look! The wages you failed to pay the workers who mowed your fields are crying out against you. The cries of the harvesters have reached the ears of the Lord Almighty."
- g. <u>Revelation 1:8</u> "I am the Alpha and the Omega," says the Lord God, "who is, and who was, and who is to come, the Almighty."
- 6. Regarding "Almighty", J.I. Packer states, "It points to the basic Bible fact that God is the Lord, the King, the **omnipotent** one who reigns over his world."
 - a. Except for "omnipotent" these are pretty simple words. Words we use every day. We get the point, right?

 - b. Psalm 135:6 "The LORD does whatever pleases him, in the heavens and on the earth, in the seas and all their depths."
 - c. <u>Psalm 33:9</u> "For he spoke, and it came to be; he commanded, and it stood firm."
 - d. God's creation in <u>Genesis 1:</u>
 - Vs 1: God spoke, "Let there be light. And there was light..."
 - Vs 6: And God said, "Let there be a vault between the waters to separate water from water."
 - Vs 9: And God said, "Let the water under the sky be gathered to one place, and let dry ground appear."

Ephesians 1:11-14 "In him we were also chosen, having been predestined according to the plan of him who works out everything in conformity with the purpose of his will, in order that we, who were the first to put our hope in Christ, might be for the praise of his glory. And you also were included in Christ when you heard the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation. When you believed, you were marked in him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit, who is a deposit guaranteeing our inheritance until the redemption of those who are God's possession—to the praise of his glory."
